Brigadier General Duane A. Gamble **Deputy Commanding General**

BG Duane A. Gamble serves as the Deputy Commanding General of the U.S. Army Sustainment Command, a position he has held since July 2012. As Deputy Commanding General, BG Gamble leads a global organization responsible for sustaining Army and Joint Forces in the US and abroad in support of combatant commanders. Prior to serving as the Deputy Commanding General, BG Gamble served at the Pentagon as Director, Force Projection and Distribution, Army G4.



A native of Arbutus, Maryland, BG Gamble graduated as a Distinguished Military Graduate and was commissioned as a 2nd Lieutenant of Ordnance at Western Maryland College in May 1985. His first assignment was Platoon Leader and Shop Officer, Company B, 2d Support Battalion, 2d Brigade, 9th Infantry Division (Motorized) at Fort Lewis, Washington. He earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree from Western Maryland College, a Master of Science Degree from the Florida Institute of Technology and a Master of Science Degree from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces.

BG Gamble commanded the 528th Sustainment Brigade (Airborne) in support of the United States Army Special Operations Command from 2007-2009; the 426th Forward Support Battalion (Air Assault) in support of 1st Brigade, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) from 2001-2003; and Company B, 782d Maintenance Battalion (Airborne) in support of 2d Brigade, 82d Airborne Division from 1990-1991. While in brigade command, BG Gamble's unit supported Army Special Operations Forces in Iraq, Afghanistan, and the Philippines. While in battalion command, BG Gamble's unit supported the Bastogne Brigade during the 2003 invasion of Iraq and during combat operations in An Najef, Al Hillah and Quarraah. While in company command, BG Gamble's unit supported the Falcon Brigade during the 1991 invasion of Iraq.

BG Gamble's staff assignments include service as the XVIIIth Airborne Corps G4; G4 for the NATO Rapid Deployable Corps - Turkey; XO to the Army Materiel Command G3; G4 for the 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault); Deputy Commanding Officer for the 46th Corps Support Group (Airborne); XO for the 307th Forward Support Battalion (Airborne); and Forward Area Support Coordination Officer and Support Operations Officer for 2d Brigade, 82d Airborne Division. BG Gamble's Operational and Joint Assignments include service as Deputy J4, United States Forces Iraq; J4, Joint Task Force Haiti; G4, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault) during Operation Iraqi Freedom; Battalion Commander during Operation Iraqi Freedom; Joint Logistics Operations Officer during Operation Joint Endeavor, Croatia; Forward Area Support Coordination Officer during Hurricane Andrew Relief Operations; and Company Commander during Operations Desert Shield and Desert Storm.

BG Gamble's awards and decorations include the Master Parachutist Badge and the Air Assault Badge.
